An ecological time for the Forum

End of Winter, beginning of Spring, beginning of Summer, succession of disasters and amazement in China: these events come as a reminder of its fragility.

This edition of the ForuMag fluctuates between perplexity and signs of opening. As the Olympic Torch arrived in Shenzhen, Pierre Calame explained to the Oeeee.com webusers how the « Olympic Game » sign became a « global social event ».

The richness of the exchanges with the participants during meetings in China shows the continuity of the Forum. After the Sichuan earthquake, many of them went on site carrying out the operation « give a hand to children » to bring together the humanitarian forces. Since then voices raise, which hails the year 2008 as the « Year I(one) of the Chinese civil society ».

On the European side, the China-Europa-Forum foundation opened a bank account « Sichuan Solidarity » and launched a project of mutualisation of experiences in post disaster reconstruction. Some participants even offered to welcome children who were victims of the earthquake.

It tends to prove that the consciousness of a unique human community could arise in the aftermath of natural disasters. Are human biengs ready to recognize the new ecological era they are living in?

Could we stand together to restore our home land, the planet Earth?
