A New Tie of Culture Protection is expected to Establish

A new tie between Chinese and European culture protection is expected to establish after Mr. Francois Launay and Mr. He Shuzhong had a 1h30 conversation.

The China-Europa Forum is making every effort to establish ties for its participants. With the help of the Forum, Mr. Launay, who is also Vice-chairman of the European Charter of Cistercian abbeys and Sites, a secular organization whose purpose is for the promotion and safeguarding of Cistercian heritage, especially in architecture, met Mr. HE Shuzhong, the founder of a Beijing-based NGO – the Beijing Culture Heritage Protection in the afternoon of Sept. 29.
